



The Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ is the most important event of our faith and impacts the whole world. In his First Letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul wrote, "If Christ has not been raised,...your faith is in

vain" (1 Cor 15:14) Through the Resurrection, Jesus shows us He is both fully man and fully God and gives us hope for eternity.

Easter should be a time of great celebration that extends beyond Easter Sunday. The days of the Octave of Easter (the first eight days of the Easter season), are each a Solemnity, the highest kind of liturgical feasts, and can be celebrated with special food and time in prayer. The Easter Season continues until Pentecost- a total of 50 days of rejoicing in the Risen Lord and hearing stories of the Risen Lord visiting His people.
