RULES AND REGULATIONS QUEEN OF HEARTS RAFFLE: (“Raffle”) is being conducted by St. Elizabeth of the Trinity, a not-for-profit religious organization. The Raffle is being conducted pursuant to the Illinois Raffles Act, 230 ILAFC 15/0.01 et seq., and the Chicago Municipal Code, all proceeds raised by the Raffle will benefit St. Elizabeth of the Trinity in fulfillment of its religious, educational and or charitable missions. The Raffle Official Rules and Regulations (the “Official Rules”) are set forth below. By purchasing a Raffle ticket (a “Ticket”), the purchaser acknowledges that they are aware of, and agrees to be bound by, these Official Rules and St. Elizabeth of the Trinity interpretation of any such Official Rules. St. Elizabeth of the Trinity shall be solely responsible for interpreting and applying the Official Rules. St. Elizabeth of the Trinity interpretation and application of such rules shall be final. St. Elizabeth of the Trinity reserves the right to amend these Official Rules upon ten (10) days’ notice provided pursuant to an update provided on St. Elizabeth of the Trinity website or otherwise published in St. Elizabeth of the Trinity bulletin or some other written medium.

Eligibility: Any individual who is 18 years of age or older at the time the Ticket is purchased is eligible to enter the Raffle.

Raffle Board: Required to utilize the Queen of Hearts manufactured raffle board. The board has been developed specifically for this Raffle. The board has a poker deck of 54 face down sealed numbered cards, which includes 2 Jokers. Under the sealed number cards is a randomly placed queen of hearts card.

Prize: Queen of Hearts is a progressive 50/50 raffle. When the queen of hearts is picked, 50% of the net proceeds will go to (1) winner. "**Net Proceeds**" means the gross receipts from the conduct of such Raffle, less the reasonable operating expenses incurred by St. Elizabeth of the Trinity as a result of operating such Raffle. The maximum Raffle pot will be \$4,000,000 with \$2,000,000 awarded to the winner, subject to the City of Chicago Municipal Code. Odds: Probability varies based on ticket sales and how many remaining cards left on the Queen of Hearts board.

Cost: Tickets will be \$5.00 per ticket. Cash will be the only form of payment accepted.

Tickets may also be available at other events when available.

Cash will be the only accepted form of payment. All sales of Tickets are final. Entries which have been or appear to be tampered with are void. All contact information shall be legible on the ticket including full name (no nicknames, abbreviations or group names) and phone number. If the Queen of Hearts is not picked, ticket sales for the next week Raffle will begin immediately following the weekly drawing. Only one (1) eligible person may be entered in the Raffle per Ticket sold. If the name of more than one (1) person is provided on a Ticket entry form and that Ticket is selected as a winning ticket, then the person named first will be deemed as the holder of record of that Ticket and declared the winner. The division of any prize among a group of persons purchasing a Ticket in common shall be the sole responsibility of the person named as the holder of record of that Ticket should that Ticket be selected as a winner. St. Elizabeth of the Trinity is not responsible for resolving any disputes that may arise from different individuals listed on a winning Ticket. An individual can purchase as many Tickets as they may wish, subject to availability. Neither St. Elizabeth of the Trinity nor its directors, officers, employees, agents or other representatives assumes any responsibility or liability for lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, incomplete, illegible or undelivered entries, or any other failure to receive entries, or any failure to deliver a receipt of purchase prior to the drawing deadlines.

Raffle Drawings: Raffle drawing will be conducted every Thursday at 8:00 pm CST by a representative of St. Elizabeth of the Trinity at Jet's Public House located at 6148 N. Milwaukee Avenue, Chicago, IL. 60646

One Ticket will be selected in a random drawing (the Drawing") from all the Tickets sold that week. If the contact information is illegible, a new Ticket will be selected. The number on the Ticket will determine which of the 54 cards on the board is opened. If no number is written on the Ticket the lowest available number on the board will be chosen. If the number on the Ticket has already been

picked, the lowest available number on the board will be opened. If the queen of hearts is not selected, the game will roll over to the next week and that card will remain face up and unavailable for future selection. The progressive raffle can last up to 54 weeks. Each week, all other Tickets not selected will be destroyed. Entrants need not be present to win. Winners will be selected at random. All orders for Tickets must be received and/or purchased by the indicated deadline to be eligible for the applicable drawing. In the event the drawing cannot be conducted at the date, time or location advertised by St. Elizabeth of the Trinity for any reason, or if a prize cannot be awarded for any reason, representatives of St. Elizabeth of the Trinity shall set a new date and location for a subsequent drawing. The holder of the Ticket drawn will receive a \$50 cash and if the holder of the Ticket is present for the drawing, the holder will receive an extra \$50.00 cash. If ticket holder is not present, you can pick up your prize money from St. Elizabeth of the Trinity Rectory, 6020 West Ardmore Avenue, Chicago, IL. 60646 between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Notification of Winners: St. Elizabeth of the Trinity will have the sole discretion to determine whether an owner of an Entry selected at the Drawing (the "Potential Winner") is an Eligible Entrant and otherwise eligible to be the winner of the Prize in accordance with these Official Rules (the "Official Winner"). As a condition of its right to collect a Prize and become an Official Winner, any Potential Winner must deliver to St. Elizabeth of the Trinity: (a) a signed statement certifying that the Potential Winner is the rightful owner of the winning Ticket or provide Ticket receipt in accordance with these Official Rules and all applicable laws. Winners will be notified according to the contact information provided to St. Elizabeth of the Trinity at the time of Ticket purchase. If a selected winner is unable to be contacted or located after reasonable attempts by St. Elizabeth of the Trinity, or if the Prize cannot be awarded for any other reason, representatives of St. Elizabeth of the Trinity shall conduct another drawing and select another Ticket in order to identify a Potential Winner. In order to collect a prize, a winner must sign and deliver to St. Elizabeth of the Trinity: (a) such written information as is required by any applicable tax and/or real estate laws, including, without limitation, Social Security Number; (b) proof of identity in forms satisfactory to St. Elizabeth of the Trinity showing that the person claiming the prize is the same person who is named on the winning Ticket. Winners may be required to submit a W-2G, Form 5754 or similar tax form (provided by St. Elizabeth of the Trinity) for tax withholding purposes and may be required to pay withholding tax in an amount required by IRS regulations.

Non-Deductibility of Ticket Purchase: The IRS has taken the position that amounts paid for chances in raffles, lotteries or similar drawings for valuable prizes are not gifts, and consequently, the purchase of a Ticket does not qualify as a deductible charitable contribution.

Taxes: There may be federal, state and/or local tax consequences of winning a prize in the Raffle. Any and all taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner. Purchasers of Tickets are advised to consult their own tax advisors with respect to tax liabilities that may arise from winning a prize in the Raffle. Winners may be required to submit a W-2G, Form 5754 or similar tax form (provided by St. Elizabeth of the Trinity) for tax withholding purposes and may be required to pay withholding tax in an amount required by IRS regulations.

Terms and Conditions: The Raffle is subject to these Official Rules. These Official Rules cannot be changed by any oral statement made by any employee, consultant or agent acting on behalf of St. Elizabeth of the Trinity. By entering the Raffle, entrants accept and agree: (1) to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of St. Elizabeth of the Trinity which shall be final and binding; (2) waive

any right to claim ambiguity in the Raffle or these Official Rules; (3) that St. Elizabeth of the Trinity may use the entrant's name, photograph, likeness, statements, or voice for promotional or advertising purposes in connection with the Raffle in all forms of media, now or hereafter known, in perpetuity, without review, permission or further compensation, except where prohibited by law.

BY ENTERING THE RAFFLE, EACH ENTRANT RELEASES St. Elizabeth of the Trinity, ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, THE CATHOLIC BISHOP OF CHICAGO, AN ILLINOIS CORPORATION SOLE, THEIR AFFILIATES AND ALL OF THEIR CLERGY, OFFICERS, AGENTS AND VOLUNTEERS FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY FOR INJURIES, LOSSES OR DAMAGES OF ANY KIND (INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ATTORNEY'S FEES) CAUSED BY PARTICIPATING IN THE RAFFLE OR WINNING ANY PRIZE OR RESULTING FROM ACCEPTANCE, POSSESSION, USE OR MISUSE OF ANY PRIZE, AND EACH WINNER AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD St. Elizabeth of the Trinity HARMLESS FROM ANY AND ALL LOSSES, DAMAGES, RIGHTS, CLAIMS AND ACTIONS OF ANY KIND ARISING FROM, IN CONNECTION WITH, OR AS A RESULT OF PARTICIPATING IN THE RAFFLE OR THE WINNER'S ACCEPTANCE OR USE OF ANY PRIZE. A RAFFLE ENTRANT'S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY FOR ANY CLAIM AGAINST St. Elizabeth of the Trinity ARISING OUT OF THE SALE OF TICKETS OR THE CONDUCT OF THE RAFFLE SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE RETURN OF THE PURCHASE PRICE PAID FOR THEIR TICKET(S). IN NO EVENT SHALL St. Elizabeth of the Trinity, ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS OR REPRESENTATIVES BE LIABLE TO ANY PARTY FOR ANY LOSS OR INJURIES TO EARNINGS, PROFITS OR GOODWILL, OR FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, PUNITIVE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY PERSON OR ENTITY WHETHER ARISING IN CONTRACT, TORT OR OTHERWISE, EVEN IF ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. ANY CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THE RAFFLE OR THESE OFFICIAL RULES SHALL BE SETTLED BY BINDING ARBITRATION ADMINISTERED BY THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION (PURSUANT TO ITS EXPEDITED PROCEDURES) UNDER ITS COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION RULES AND CONDUCTED IN CHICAGO, ILLINOIS. JUDGMENT ON THE AWARD RENDERED BY THE ARBITRATOR MAY BE ENTERED IN ANY COURT HAVING JURISDICTION THEREOF.

Cancellation/Termination of Raffle: By purchasing a Ticket and choosing to participate in the Raffle, each Raffle participant acknowledges and agrees that St. Elizabeth of the Trinity has the right, in its sole discretion, to elect not to proceed with the Raffle for any reason whatsoever or for no reason. In such an event St. Elizabeth of the Trinity will conduct one final drawing in which Tickets will be drawn until the Queen of Hearts location is determined on the board.
