June: The Month of the Sacred Heart

This year, Friday, June 11th is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the entire month of June is devoted to His Sacred Heart. This whole month acknowledgement is a reminder of Christ's deep love for His creation. Artwork depicting the Sacred Heart shows Jesus' heart exposed, lit with flames at the top, along with the Crown of Thorns and the wound from Christ's side. These symbols remind us that Christ loves each of us so much that He was willing to give us Himself both through His death on the Cross and in the Eucharist.

Another beautiful devotion is the Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, which, this year, falls on Saturday, June 12th. Our Lady was the only person to love God perfectly and the love in her heart is a model for us.
