Summer with the Saints: Queen of Saints

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary's Assumption, which Pope Pius XII declared a dogma of the Catholic Church in 1950. On this day, we celebrate that Our Blessed Mother was assumed (taken up) body and soul into Heaven. Evidence of this belief dates back to the early Church where liturgies were sung and icons were made to commemorate the event.

This feast day is one of the most cheerful in the Church. Throughout Eastern Europe, girls bring bouquets to church for blessings and in Poland parades wind through the villages carrying flowers to the local church. Some ways to celebrate this feast at home:

- Go to Mass
- Pray the Glorious Mysteries together as a family
- Create a Mary Garden (indoors or outdoors) around your family's statue of Our Lady using any blue flowers (the color of Our Lady- you could try Morning Glories or Bachelor Buttons), Roses, Marigolds ("Mary's Gold"), Rosemary (has her name in there) or Lilies, a symbol of the Annunciation
