St. John Bosco epitomized the virtue of friendliness particularly by reaching out to disadvantaged youth especially the poverty ridden, the homeless, unemployed and those who committed crimes. He saw the good and potential in youth. He established schools and apprenticeships to offer many positive possibilities to the youth he encountered.

St. John Bosco, commonly known as Don Bosco, is the founder of the

Salesian order which has established schools of all kinds. These technical, agricultural and printing schools serve students from the primary years through college. He also established an order of women, Daughters of Our Lady, Help of Christians, to do for girls what he had already done for boys.

Don Bosco, used friendliness and fatherly guidance to unite love of God with one's work, study, and play. He said, "Pray when it's time to pray. Study when it's time to study. Play when it's time to play. Show kindness to everyone you meet. But do it all for the love of Jesus."*
